Why choose this course?

The Buckingham transfer course enables you to transfer your credits and turn your diploma into a degree with only three more terms of study, or take our flexible part-time options over two years. You will study alongside our mainstream art history students and enjoy the same high degree of personal attention from the teaching staff. There are also options for transferring into our first year, if you have accumulated 90 units of credit (please talk to our Admissions Office).

- Frequent class trips to museums and historic properties and a four-day study trip to Vienna
- Hands-on object-based learning
- Close links with museums, heritage organisations and the art market
- Varied range of subjects, including design and decorative arts, art markets and museum studies

As a History of Art student at Buckingham you will be joining a small but lively community of British and international students.

Assessment

Coursework plays a major role in the assessment of all the modules. Some are assessed wholly by written work (usually an essay and a shorter paper), others (Design and Decorative Arts, Collectors, Connoisseurs and Art Dealers, Museums and Art History) are 50% assessed by exam and 50% by one essay. The dissertation is double-weighted at 30 credits and wholly assessed by the completed work.

- Critical Concepts and Developments in Art History
- Study tour: Secession Vienna
- Design and Decorative Arts: Renaissance to Industrialisation
- Arts and Crafts to Bauhaus
- Collectors, Connoisseurs and Art Dealers: Collecting, Patronage and the Art Market
- Museums and Art History
- Dissertation
