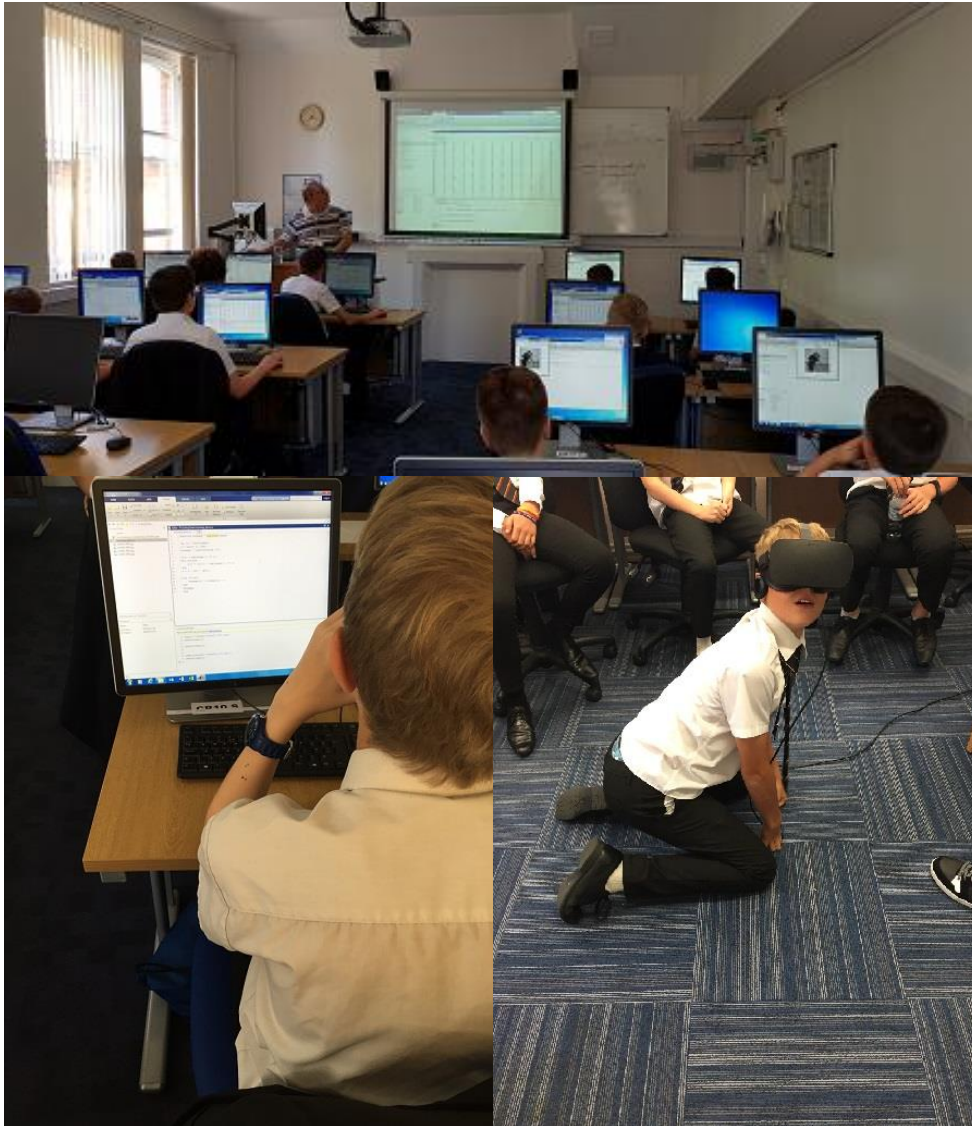


University of Buckingham – School of Computing
